### **DARLINGTON LOCAL PLAN: MAIN MODIFICATIONS**

- 1. Thank you for consulting with the Home Builders Federation (HBF) on the Darlington Local Plan Main Modifications.
- 2. The HBF is the principal representative body of the house-building industry in England and Wales. Our representations reflect the views of our membership, which includes multi-national PLC's, regional developers and small, local builders. In any one year, our members account for over 80% of all new "for sale" market housing built in England and Wales as well as a large proportion of newly built affordable housing.
- 3. The HBF would like to submit the following comments on the proposed Main Modifications.

## MM25: Policy H1

4. The Council propose to amend this policy to set the housing requirement as a single minimum net figure of 492 dwellings per annum (dpa) and 9,840 overall. The HBF generally supports the Council in improving the clarity of this policy by moving to a single net housing requirement.

### MM40 and MM41: Policy H4

- 5. The Council propose to amend this policy to state that housing development will be <u>encouraged</u> to provide an appropriate mix of housing types, sizes and tenures which <u>have regard to</u> local needs as identified within the most up to date SHMA <u>or other relevant evidence</u>. The HBF generally supports the Council in making these modifications.
- 6. The Council also propose to amend the policy to reduce the requirement for M4(2) dwellings from 80% to 45% to reflect the evidence. The HBF considers that this amendment is appropriate.

### MM43: Policy H5

7. The Council propose to amend this policy to include the tenure split as well as the affordable housing requirement for each location. This amendment has been undertaken

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to ensure consistency with the NPPF requirement for affordable home ownership. The HBF generally supports the proposed amendment.

- 8. I trust that the Council will find these comments useful as it continues to progress its Local Plan. I would be happy to discuss these issues in greater detail or assist in facilitating discussions with the wider house building industry.
