HBF SECURES FUNDING TO DELIVER NEW UPSKILLING MASTERCLASSES

HBF has successfully secured CITB funding to deliver hundreds more brickwork masterclasses and roll out brand new roofing masterclass sessions. The training will enhance the skills of thousands of bricklayers and roofers and will be fully funded.

The masterclasses have been developed in partnership with NHBC, the Association of Brickwork Contractors (ABC) and the National Federation of Roofing Contractors (NFRC). to deliver practical skills and knowledge on the common issues found by NHBC inspection teams. The initiative aims to minimise defects and warranty claims within key build areas.

The brickwork masterclasses were initially launched in 2019 and since then have trained more than 10,400 bricklayers across 1,100 training sessions.

The training is being funded by CITB as part of its £3 million investment into initiatives to support the Home Building Sector Skills plan. These projects will provide new ways to improve skills, training and recruitment in the home building industry.

The 90-minute masterclasses can be delivered at participants sites across England, Wales and Scotland and are available to book via the NHBC website www.nhbc.co.uk/shop/training-courses.

WOMEN INTO SITE MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME WELCOMES THIRD COHORT

The Women into Site Management programme successfully launched its third cohort, with 22 women offered a place on the programme. The training scheme provides career routes for women into site management roles, including three weeks of learning through insight and work experience.

The programme has been created in partnership with Women into Construction (WIC) and nine major home builders to help address the gender imbalance in the home building sector and diversify the workforce. Since launching in January 2023, the programme has supported 49 women to complete on site work placements and provide training and ongoing support.

CITB SECTOR SPECIALIST EMPLOYER NETWORK FOR HOMEBUILDING

The CITB Home Building Sector Network Pilot has now been extended to cover the whole of England. Aimed at small and medium companies, CITB will arrange free or subsidised home building specific training without the need for businesses to claim a grant for the relevant training. Larger home builders can also get involved to support supply chain training.

HAYDOCK PARK OPENS ITS DOORS FOR HOME BUILDING CAREER EVENT

In September, for the second consecutive year, HBF North West members and Haydock Park, in Merseyside, hosted a Careers and Raceday event, supported by HBF. The event brought together home builders and their associates across the North West to showcase careers in the industry, explore career pathways and discuss entry routes with pupils from schools and colleges in the region. The event allowed employers to shift perceptions about the home building industry and get more young people to consider a career in home building.

Over 280 students attended the event, receiving valuable insight and a chance to speak to home builder employers directly.

DEPARTMENT FOR WORK AND PENSIONS (DWP) INSIGHT WEEK SHOWCASES HOME BUILDING CAREERS

HBF's Home Building Skills Partnership recently worked with the Department of Work and Pensions (DWP) to collate several helpful resources and links for Job Centre staff on careers within the home building industry. The content was delivered as part of DWP's dedicated Construction insight week, where DWP staff can learn more about different sectors, so they have the knowledge and understanding needed to share opportunities with job seekers.

HBF's Skills Partnership shared videos, career experiences opportunities and background information on skills and experience needed for various careers. Over 37 districts and 710 Job Centre offices accessed the information with positive feedback.
