4.01 Action: HBF Digital Construction Supplier Readiness Survey to be sent out **RS** to suppliers that are yet to fill out it out. Deadline for HBF to receive responses needs to be set.

- 4.02 IM suggested that pressure is applied to those small organisations that do not yet use BIM to also fill out the survey, to find out why and to understand what are the hurdles they need to overcome. This would enable the group to see if they can assist.
- 4.03 **Action:** HBF to build a case study to share with suppliers, so they can see **ALL** the long-term benefits using BIM would provide them with. All members to provide any suggestions of case studies that could be developed.
- 4.04 GM suggested that we state 'HBF on behalf of (each member company that takes part in this group)' as this may give the survey more weight and prompt suppliers to complete it.
- 4.05 Action: Group to come up with a set of developer led model content ALL protocols, which will create a common goal. (something along the lines of a BIM Bible)

PC suggested that in collaboration with the BIM4Housing Group the NHBC **PC** may be able to help with this project. PC agreed to start the ball rolling and he will send an email to CF to share with the group in order to develop the scope to present to Neil Smith at the NHBC for consideration.
